*	A person identified as a close contact will be asked to quarantine for 14 days from their last exposure to the positive individual. A close contact is defined as a person that had close contact (within 6 feet) of the infected individual, did not have on a facial covering, and had more than 15 minutes of exposure to the infected individual. Contacts of a contact do not need to quarantine until the contact they had contact with becomes symptomatic.
