State of Ohio Public Emergency County Levels

St Paul UCC Service & Event Guidance Yellow Level 1

Public Emergency: active exposure and spread.

In Person Service with transmission to parking lot

Limited Pre-approved activities

Orange Level 2

Public Emergency: increased exposure and spread.

Exercise high degree of caution.

In Person Service with transmission to parking lot

Very limited pre-approved activities

Red Level 3

Public Emergency: very high exposure and spread. Limit activities as much as possible.

In Person Service with transmission to parking lot No Sunday School or other activities

No other activities

Purple Level4

Public Emergency: severe exposure and spread. Only leave home for supplies and services.

Virtual Only

No other activities

Virtual service can be done at anytime in addition to the in person or transmitted to parking lot services.

Updated November 9, 2020

From the Ottawa County Health Department

A person identified as a close contact will be asked to quarantine for 14 days from their last exposure to the positive individual. A close contact is defined as a person that had close contact (within 6 feet) of the infected individual, did not have on a facial covering, and had more than 15 minutes of exposure to the infected individual. Contacts of a contact do not need to quarantine until the contact they had contact with becomes symptomatic.
